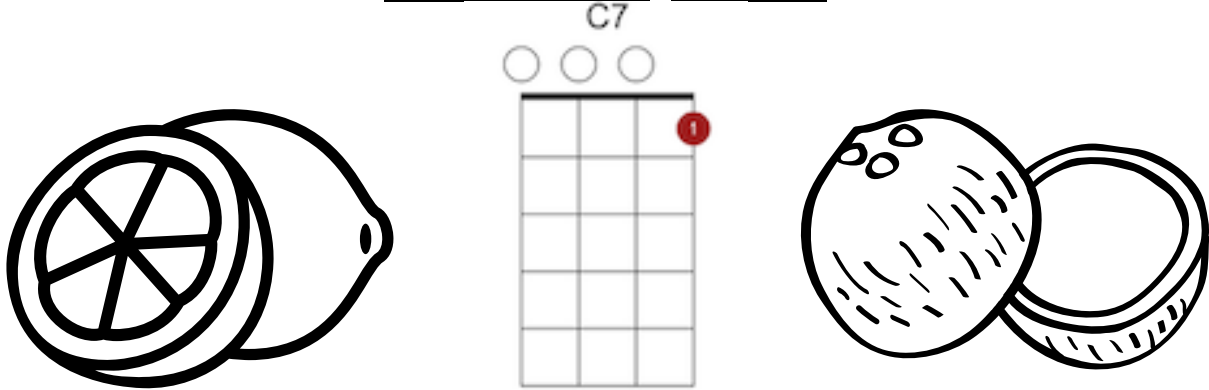
My Ukulele has a body

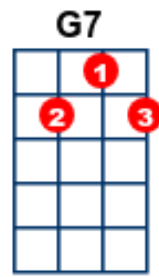
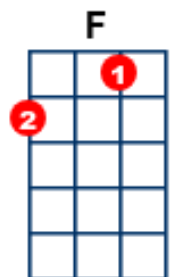
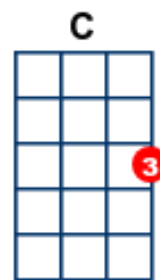
Baa Baa Black Sheep
